Create something interesting of your choice (e.g. poster, PowerPoint, art piece etc.) to share with the rest of your class.</p>	<p>In science, we are learning about 'Light'. Investigate what 'light refraction' is and write an explanation with accompanied labelled drawings to support your explanation.</p>
