



Year 3 Optional Extension Tasks – Spring Term

As promised, please find below a list of optional extension tasks which your child may like to complete during this half term. As you know, we have our essential weekly homework tasks (outlined in your Welcome Booklet) and the family-friendly 'Weekend Wonders' passport card. For those parents or pupils who thrive on more in-depth study, try out some of the ideas below. Your class teacher would love to see the final result, however, formal feedback will not take place as these are optional extensions.

Create a leaflet for a famous landmark in England. You should include the following things in your leaflet:

- What is the landmark called?
- Where is the landmark located?
- Why is it famous?
- What can you do there?
- Interesting facts about the landmark
- Pictures

Research a famous landmark in England and create a poster about it. You may want to include the following:

- Key facts about the landmark
- Quiz or word search related to the landmark
- Pictures

Create your **own 3D model** of a landmark. Your model should be able to stand up by itself to be displayed.



Create a sales pitch to present to the class explaining why the Year 3 teachers should invest money in your new landmark. You should include:

- The name of the landmark
- Where it will be built/Where is your landmark located?
- How much will it cost to make?
- Key features of your landmark
- Facts about your landmark
- Explain why we should invest in your landmark
- Persuasive language

This sales pitch can be in the form of a poster or written out but will be shared with your class during your pitch.
