<p>During this term we are learning about the South America and the Amazon River in our geography lessons. There are many fascinating things about this region of the world such as the Amazon Rainforest, impact of deforestation, topography of land etc. What can you find out about the key aspects of South America and/or the Amazon River? Create something interesting of your choice (e.g. poster, PowerPoint, art piece etc.) to share with the rest of your class.</p>	<p>In science, we are learning about 'Animals, including Humans'. Research your favourite animal and create an information booklet about it. This information booklet could contain information on: appearance, habitat, life cycle, diet, behaviour as well as labelled images of the animal.</p>
<p>During our PSHE lessons this term we will be learning about 'Relationships'. Create an attractive spider diagram with you in the centre and each branch identifying a different person you have a relationship with and how this relationship is important to you. Think beyond your immediate family e.g. friends, teachers etc.</p>	<p>We are studying Buddhism this term in our RE lessons. Wesak and Parinirvana are very special festivals in the Buddhist religion. Create your own fact file on these two festivals clearly explaining what each festival represents and the traditions observed during these festivals.</p>
